

COOK MEMORIAL PRIZE

This prize arises from a fund raised by subscriptions among members of the University and others in commemoration of the services of the late Professor C H H Cook, M.A., late Fellow of St John's College, Cambridge, who held the chair of Mathematics and Natural Philosophy in Canterbury College from 1874 to 1908.

1. There shall be a prize, to be called the Cook Memorial Prize, to be open to competition annually.
2. The prize shall consist of a cash grant.
3. The prizes shall be open to all students on the books of the University of Canterbury who are taking Honours in Mathematics.
4. The prize shall be awarded on the honours courses in Mathematics, to the candidate who, in the opinion of the examiners, is most deserving of this distinction, provided the candidate gained first class honours.

NOTE: The current value of the prize is \$500.
