

THE JANE ROUNICK MEMORIAL AWARD

The Jane Rounick Memorial Award is made each year to a sculpture student who, in the year in which the award is made, must be in the final year of a B F A, a B F A (Hons), or an M F A.

The award will be made on merit, by the Council of the University of Canterbury upon the recommendation of a selection committee including one representative of the Jane Rounick family.

Applications for the award will be made to the Senior Lecturer in Sculpture in the year of the award. Proposals will be requested early in Term 1 in the year of the award, and the date will be determined by the Senior Lecturer in Sculpture at the start of the year. Proposals for the award will include a submission of recent sculptural work and proposal for work to be undertaken for that year.

The value of the award shall be \$3,000 per annum, to be paid in two instalments: the first at the beginning of Term 1 and the second following the final course submission in October. The final instalment will be made on receipt, by the selection committee of the fully documented record of the year's work showing satisfactory progress.
